Itinerary

Monday, December 22:

Meals: L,D

We drive the Coquihalla and arrive in mid-afternoon at **Harrison Hot Springs Resort**. Our accommodation is in the West Tower near the pool and spa area. Then we go to McCaw Hall to enjoy the familiar music of Tchaikovsky's **The Nutcracker** with the incredible

dancing of Pacific Northwest Ballet. This amazing Christmas production is celebrating its 31st season on stage.

Thursday, December 25:

Meals: B,D

Merry Christmas! Expect a visit from Santa Claus! A hospitality room is provided by the hotel where you can meet other Christmas travellers and socialize or play games. Tonight's reception is followed by **Christmas Dinner** served in the green oasis of the atrium. Afterwards, there is a lights drive past lavishly-decorated homes at Mill Creek.

Friday, December 26:

Meals: B

This morning, transportation is provided to nearby **Alderwood Mall** to take advantage of the Boxing Day specials. The mall has 200 stores anchored by JC Penney, Macy's, Nordstrom and Sears. The afternoon is leisure time. Tonight, we go to the Fifth Avenue Theatre and see **A Christmas Story, The Musical**. In 1940s Indiana, a bespectacled boy named Ralphie has a big imagination and one wish for Christmas—a Red Ryder BB Gun. A kooky leg lamp, outrageous pink bunny pajamas, a cranky department store Santa, and a triple-dog-dare to lick a freezing flagpole are just a few of the obstacles that stand between Ralphie and his Christmas dream. *A Christmas Story, The Musical* is holiday entertainment that captures a simpler time with delicious wit and a heart of gold. After two triumphant seasons on Broadway, this hilarious musical returns home to The Fifth where it all began.

Saturday, December 27:

Meals: B

We stop at **Bellis Fair Mall** in Bellingham and the Duty-Free Store at Sumas, then we cross the border and head home on the Coquihalla.

Tour Policies

Payments: A deposit of \$200 per person is requested at the time of booking and the balance is due November 6, 2014.

Discounts: Early bookers receive \$70 discount on first 15 seats and \$35 on next 10 seats for booking early with deposit. The discount is not offered after November 6.

Cancellation Policy: Up to October 6, your tour payments will be refunded less an administrative charge of \$40 per person. From October 7 to November 6, the cancellation charge is \$100 per person. From November 7 to November 19, the cancellation charge is 40% of tour fare. From November 20 to December 4, the cancellation charge is 70% of tour fare. After December 4, there is no refund.

Fare Changes: Changes to taxes and surcharges from tour suppliers can occur at any time and are beyond the control of Wells Gray Tours, therefore Wells Gray Tours reserves the right to increase fares due to such changes up until the time of departure.
